Burke, a Paid Up For Life (PUFL) member of Post 139. William served honorably in the U.S. Navy during World War II aboard the USS Catoctin (AGC-5). The USS Catoctin has the distinction of serving as the communications ship and as headquarters for the advance party planning the Yalta Conference in Sevastopol, Russia where U.S. President Franklin D. Roosevelt, British Prime Minister Winston Churchill, and Soviet Premier Joseph Stalin made important decisions regarding the future progress of the war and the postwar world. Mr. Burke became a member of Post 139 after he returned from his tour overseas. Once his son, Bill, returned from his service in Vietnam, William encouraged Bill to join Post 139 and through this common bond, the father and son team built many memories and formed lifelong bonds with fellow Legionnaires.

The pool table, not coincidentally, has a Navy Blue felt covering in honor of William's military service.
